## **MILTON PHILLIPS, JR. AWARD**

A professional continuing educator who sincerely believed in and effectively promoted the concept of “lifelong learning”.

The individual:

- Must be a current member of TACHE or have been a member for a minimum of five years.
- Cannot be a current TACHE officer.
- Has been a professional continuing educator for a minimum of five years.
- Has a demonstrated record of outstanding service and leadership in continuing education and/or higher education in Tennessee.
- Has promoted the concept of Lifelong Learning in Tennessee.
- Has a documented history of supporting innovation and creativity in the field of continuing/higher education in Tennessee.

## **BARBARA BEELER AWARD**

In recognition of outstanding service to the membership in TACHE.

The individual has:

- Made extraordinary contributions to TACHE over an extended period of time, five years minimum.
- Served in a minimum of two positions on the TACHE Executive Committee.
- Improved the professional life of continuing/higher education practitioners in TACHE.
- A documented record of mentoring the new members of TACHE.
- Played an active role in numerous TACHE annual conferences.

## **MERIT AWARD**

The individual:

- Must be a member of TACHE.
- Must have served in two leadership roles in TACHE.
- Has provided outstanding leadership in TACHE.
- Has promoted and advocated the goals of TACHE.
- Has a record of extraordinary contributions to TACHE.

## **DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD**

Purpose of this award is to annually recognize an individual for their outstanding and/or significant contributions to TACHE.

- Must be a current member of TACHE.
- Have been a member for a minimum of five years.
- Cannot be a current TACHE Officer.
- Has demonstrated record of outstanding services in TACHE for three years or has made significant contributions to TACHE over an extended period of time.
- Recipient should NOT have previously received the Barbara Beeler Award or the Milton J. Phillips, Jr. Award.

**The following *Non-Credit Award,*  
*Credit Program Award* and  
*Technical Award***

**may be given to an individual or institution that has demonstrated outstanding or innovative programming. It is perfectly acceptable to nominate one of your own outstanding programs for consideration; however, the same individual/institution is not eligible to receive this award for two consecutive years. Also, please note that one of the criteria is that the program must be easily replicated at other institutions.**

## **NON-CREDIT PROGRAM AWARD**

Purpose of this award is to recognize an individual or institution demonstrating outstanding and/or innovative non-credit programming. Any individual or institutional member of TACHE may submit nominations for the award. The same individual/institution is not eligible to receive this award for two consecutive years.

Program must:

- Be less than five years old.
- Reflect originality in approach, content, delivery.
- Be marketed towards new audiences or innovative format.
- Be easily replicated at other institutions.

## **CREDIT PROGRAM AWARD**

Purpose of this award is to recognize an individual or institution demonstrating outstanding and/or innovative credit programming. Any individual or institutional member of TACHE may submit nominations for the award. The same individual/institution is not eligible to receive this award for two consecutive years.

Program must:

- Be less than five years old.
- Reflect originality in approach, content, delivery.
- Be marketed towards new audiences or innovative format.
- Be easily replicated at other institutions.
- Award college level credit that can lead toward an associate, baccalaureate or graduate degree.

## **TECHNICAL PROGRAM AWARD**

Purpose of this award is to recognize an individual or technical postsecondary institution that demonstrates outstanding and/or innovative technical programming. Any individual or institutional member of TACHE may submit nominations for the award. The same individual/institution is not eligible to receive this award for two consecutive years.

Program must:

- Be less than five years old.
- Reflect originality in approach, content, delivery.
- Be marketed towards new audiences or innovative format.
- Be easily replicated at other institutions.
- Be a diploma program that can be or has the potential to be transferred to other state institutions.
